IN RE: DESIGNATION OF RECORD NEWSPAPER FOR PUBLICATION OF LEGAL NOTICES

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice; and

WHEREAS, Section 50.0711, Florida Statutes, requires the designation of a record newspaper qualifying under the terms of Section 50.011, Florida Statutes, by a majority of judges in the circuit and

WHEREAS, the current designated newspaper of record, the DAILY BUSINESS REVIEW, has notified the clerk of court that it is ceasing print operations in December, and will not be accepting any new notices as of November 22, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

- 1. Effective November 22, 2023, MIAMI'S COMMUNITY NEWS is designated by a majority of judges in the circuit as the record newspaper for those matters set forth in Section 50.0711.
- 2. Court Administration Order No. 74-1 and Common Law No. 19007 "Order



Designating Official Court Newspaper" (attachment) are hereby rescinded and held for naught.

This Administrative Order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until further order of the court.
