NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Homestead (the "City") will hold a Fiscal Year 2025 Second Public Budget Hearing/Special Call Council Meeting in accordance with authorized communications media technology protocols, as provided on the City's website, and the meeting agendas, on the below referenced item at a City Council meeting on **Wednesday, September 18, 2024, at 5:01 p.m.**

The City of Homestead proposes to adopt the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR EACH OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2024, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2025; APPROVING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Council with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, that person will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
