

## REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) Community Rating System (CRS) No. 2025-00-001

The Village of Palmetto Bay is currently soliciting proposals from a qualified firm to review the Village's current Community Rating System (CRS) Program and prepare the Village to improve its CRS classification from 5 to 4 or better, which services are to be provided with certain specific performance measures defined by this RFQ. The Village will receive sealed proposals no later than 3:00 p.m. on or before Friday, November 1st, 2024 (late submittals, email submittals, and facsimile submissions will not be accepted) by the Village Clerk at the Village Hall Municipal Center located at 9705 East Hibiscus Street, Palmetto Bay, Florida 33157. All proposals received will be publicly opened and read aloud on said date and time before the Procurement Specialist.

To be considered, all interested Parties must request copies of the documents and submit one (1) original and a flash drive containing a copy of the entire original submission in one (1) sealed package titled "Community Rating System (CRS) RFQ# 2025-00-001". THE PACKAGE MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED TO THE ATTENTION OF THE VILLAGE CLERK, INCLUDING THE PACKAGE TITLE. The respondent shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the response to the solicitation.

A pre-submission meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday**, **October 16th**, **2024**, **at 3:00 p.m.** at the Village Hall Municipal Center at 9705 E. Hibiscus Street, Palmetto Bay, FL 33157.
